



## *Request for Culvert Repair*

When is a permit needed? A permit is required for a malfunctioning culvert. From time to time, culverts within the right of way of the City of Simonton roads need to be repaired or in some cases replaced when repairs are not feasible. Residents can request culvert inspections and repairs using this form.

Take note:

- The permit for new culverts is titled Residential Pipe Permit.
- Minor maintenance of culvert and ditches such as mowing, debris removal, and removing leaves is the responsibility of the resident whose property is connected to the culvert/ditch.
