I understand the issued permit is valid for (14) fourteen days from the issue date.

I understand any application for a permit shall at the time of making application, furnish proof of compensation insurance for his employees as provided by the laws of the state, and he shall file with the City Secretary a certificate of insurance evidencing the carrying of public liability insurance in an amount not less than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) issued by an insurance carrier authorized to transaction business in the state. In lieu of insurance, the applicant may file with the City Secretary a bond in the amount of one hundred thousand (\$100,000) issued by authorized surety company, conditioned upon the applicant's payment of all damages to persons or property which may result from or be caused by such public display of fireworks, or any negligence on the part of the applicant or his agents, employees or subcontractors in the presentation of the public displays.

I understand the issued permit is based the acknowledgement that I will adhere to the requirement of Ordinance 010321

I understand the range of aerial display shall not be more than two hundred (200) feet and the fireworks shall be discharged vertically from steel tubes
